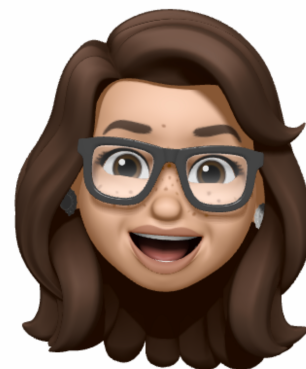


Camp Australia OSHC Newsletter
