- Payment of the non-refundable \$50 application fee must be received by Foxwell State Secondary College by the Closing Date in order for your child's Program of Excellence application to be considered.

All application documentation and payments must be received by Foxwell State Secondary College by this date in order for your child's Program of Excellence application to be reviewed and assessed.

Review & Eligibility Criteria Assessment

Your child's Program of Excellence application will be reviewed in tandem with the results attained at the below on-site assessment at Foxwell State Secondary College. It is mandatory for all applicants to attend the below assessment (relevant to their specific program).

- Advanced Learning Program and Gen-STEM Entry Tests (Sat 18 June)
- Creative Voices Auditions (Mon 20 June by booking)
- Sporting Minds Trials (Thurs 16 June or Mon 20 June)

Goals

Gen-STEM (Generation-STEM) is an Excellence Program that empowers females* and allows them to pursue their passion and interest across the various disciplines of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM).

Female* students with a passion for STEM will be provided with mentoring from our proud partnerships including Wonder of Science, University of Queensland, programs, challenges and competitions at a state, national and international level and engage with like-minded students across the world.

*Individuals that identify as female or other non-binary definitions of gender.

Eligibility Criteria

- Female* student with an interest or passion for STEM or inquiry based learning.
- Evidence of excellence in academic achievement, demonstrated through High level+ achievement in Maths and Science (previous school reports)
- High level+ results for Effort and Behaviour (previous school reports)
- Completion of Excellence Program entry test, pending outcome

ALP is an advanced learning pathways program designed to engage students in higher-order, creative and lateral thinking skills and processes, problem solving and decision making.

This program places like-minded students in a challenging and rigorous environment, designed to celebrate academic excellence and enable each student to reach their full academic potential.

Goals

The Sporting Minds High Performance Sports Program will nurture and develop the physical, mental, social and emotional potential of high-performing student athletes.

This program will recognise emerging elite athletes and assist them in achieving excellence in both sport and academics. With the right attitude, motivation, and support, almost anything is possible and this program will maximise elite athletes' potential.

This program, with its focus on athletic development including strength and conditioning, nutrition and sports psychology, will provide unique opportunities for all participating students, regardless of their chosen sport/s.

Eligibility Criteria

- Evidence of satisfactory level of academic achievement (previous school reports)
- Satisfactory level+ results for Effort and Behaviour (previous school reports)
- Evidence of engagement in representative level of their chosen sport/s
- Completion of Recommendation Form from their current sporting coach
- Completion of Excellence Program trials, pending outcome



Goals

Creative Voices will extend and accelerate students in music, drama, and/or public speaking.

Creative Voices will provide a platform for students to broaden their skills by working collaboratively with other students, industry artists/speakers, teachers and guest professionals.

The program will inspire, provide student mentoring and prepare students for a career in the arts, public speaking or in community advocacy or engagement.

Eligibility Criteria

- High level+ achievement in English (previous school reports)
- High level+ results for Effort and Behaviour (previous school reports)
- Completion of Creative Voices audition, pending outcome
- Written reflection on audition at conclusion of audition (stimulus provided)
