Invite someone in for a ‘chat’.	9 Draw a picture of your mum or dad. Say ‘why’ you love them.
10 Call or video message a friend or family member and tell them a funny joke.	11 Play ‘Mystery Word’. Say words very slowly – can they guess them? e.g. ‘r-oa-d’	12 Go on a colour walk. Look out for only your colour along the way.	13 Draw with chalk on the concrete. Think of as many ‘b’ words as you can!	14 Sort building blocks into piles by colour, shape, size.	15 Take turns hiding an object around the house. ‘Where’ did you find it?	16 What are all the things you can do with a balloon? Try some!
17 Go for a walk around your neighbourhood. Spot five things beginning with ‘m’.	18 Close your eyes and imagine your favourite ice-cream. Describe what you see.	19 Ask ‘why’ we do things. ‘Why’ do we wear coats? ‘Why’ do we brush our teeth?	20 Make a video of yourself telling a story. Use ‘first’, ‘next’, ‘last’.	21 Go outside and look at the clouds. Can you see any shapes? Talk about what you see.	22 Draw your favourite toy. Say ‘why’ it is your favourite.	23 Find five things in the kitchen that are ‘little’.
24 Go on a Rainbow Scavenger Hunt. Find one thing of every colour of the rainbow.	25 ‘Paint’ with water on the fence. Can you paint your name?	26 Set up a pretend grocery shop. Write a list and go shopping!	27 Draw your favourite animal. Describe what your animal looks like.	28 Talk about a scary animal you know. Use ‘ferocious’.	29 Make an obstacle course. Tell someone ‘how’ to do it.	30 Draw or take photos of all the things you ‘do’ today. Make a story of your day.
